South Korea, along with Taiwan, are good success cases to emulate in overcoming the middle-income trap to become economically advanced countries, as discussed at the Business Forum in Jakarta 2022.

Countries like South Korea and Taiwan exemplify successful strategies for overcoming the middle-income trap and achieving advanced economic status. Their focus, strategic planning, and competitiveness offer valuable lessons. One key insight from their experience is the importance of fostering dependencies that can drive economic growth.

Korea is one of the few countries that has successfully transformed itself from a low-income to a high-income economy and a global leader in innovation and technology. The International Monetary Fund (IMF), FTSE Russell, and S&P Dow Jones now classify South Korea as a developed country.

The fact that Korea's economic development occurred within such a short period of time is drawing attention from many developing countries. Furthermore, the strategic growth of manufacturing with a focus on heavy industry as a foundation for expedited growth in the 1970s has become the birthplace of companies like Samsung, LG, Hyundai, POSCO, and Lotte, which are now leading the world in their areas.

Driving Indonesia 4.0 & industrial down streaming to be leading the world, the success stories of Korean companies that have followed a similar trajectory can provide management insight.

As we celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Diplomatic Ties between Korea & Indonesia, we hope the CEO school contributes to the acceleration of Korea-Indonesia cooperation and the mutual growth of these two leaders in Asia.
